

## Update on Policy Convergence Process on Sustainable Forestry for Food Security and Nutrition

This document outlines the proposed process, timeframe, and procedures for reaching agreement on the policy recommendations for ‘Sustainable Forestry for Food Security and Nutrition’, informed by the High Level Panel of Experts report.

This proposal aims to build on the experience and lessons learned of past years<sup>1</sup> in the Committee’s efforts at continuous improvement, while retaining the core elements of:

- **Inclusivity** –that all stakeholders that are interested in engaging are able to;
- **Quality** – allowing sufficient time to review the HLPE report and discuss the findings and recommendations without compromising final negotiated outcome;
- **Flexibility** – using all tools available to arrive at consensus depending on the specific issue at hand and interest of stakeholders involved.

Stakeholders are asked to submit written comments on the Rapporteur's Proposal  <b>Deadline for comments:</b>	By 2 October	
Two day interpreted session to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• hear comments and issues from all stakeholders on the full Rapporteur's Proposal,</li> <li>• identify areas of contention for attention by informal working groups,</li> <li>• agree on consensus text.</li> </ul>	5-6 October	Allows almost two weeks after receipt of Rapporteur's Proposal to consult with capitals/stakeholders and prepare input for reaching consensus. The Rapporteur's proposal would be in English only.
Plenary session	9 – 13 October 2017	Discussion focused on issues and implementation. Potential to bring in case study presenters from different areas of policy practice.  After-hours negotiations as needed, in English, 9 and 10 October, for endorsement on 11.

The process for reaching agreement (e.g. tracking verbatim on screen, note taking, Rapporteur's proposal frequency) will be left to the Rapporteur and to the discussion carried out with stakeholders on 12 July. The form or style that any informal meeting takes will be up to each group.
